FROM NORTH GEORGIA (MACON):

Take I-75 South.

Take exit 99 for GA-300 toward Ga-Fla-Pkwy/Albany for 0.4 mi

Turn right at GA-300 S and go 35.1 mi

Turn right at Clark Ave and go 1.3 mi

Take the ramp onto GA-520 W/US-19 N/US-82 W and go 4.6 mi

Take exit 6A to merge onto GA-3 N/N Slappey Blvd/ US-19 N/US-82 BUS W toward Atlanta
Continue to follow GA-3 N/US-19 N for 2.2 mi

Turn left at Tabatha and go 0.1 mi

Tabatha turns slightly left and becomes Lynwood Ln for 0.3 mi

Turn right at Laurelbrook Dr
Destination will be on the left

FROM SOUTH GEORGIA (VALDOSTA):

Take I-75 North

Take exit 62 for US-82/GA-520 for 0.4 mi

Turn left at W 7th St/GA-520 W/US-82 W
Continue to follow GA-520 W/US-82 W for 32.1 mi

Continue onto GA-520 BUS W/US-82 BUS W for 4.9 mi

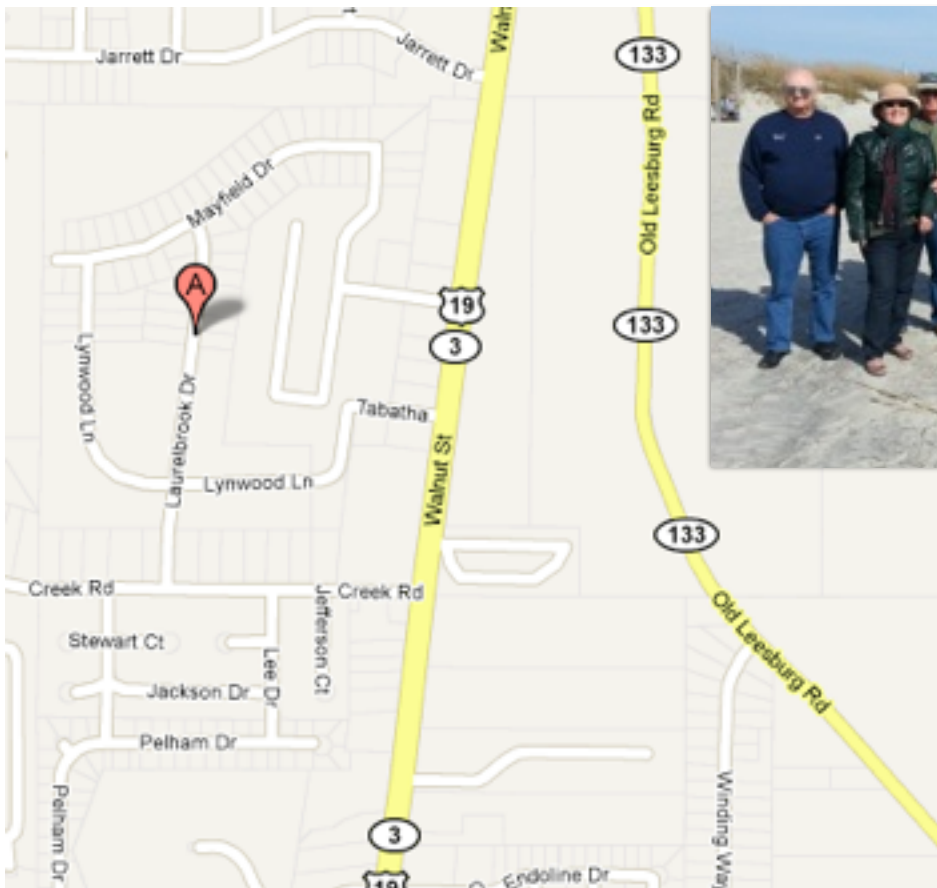
Slight right to merge onto GA-300 N/US-19 N toward GA-520 W/US-82 W/Leesburg/Dawson/GA-133 Continue to follow US-19 N for 5.2 mi

Take exit 6A to merge onto GA-3 N/N Slappey Blvd/ US-19 N/US-82 BUS W toward Atlanta
Continue to follow GA-3 N/US-19 N for 2.2 mi

Turn left at Tabatha and go 0.1 mi

Tabatha turns slightly left and becomes Lynwood Ln for 0.3 mi

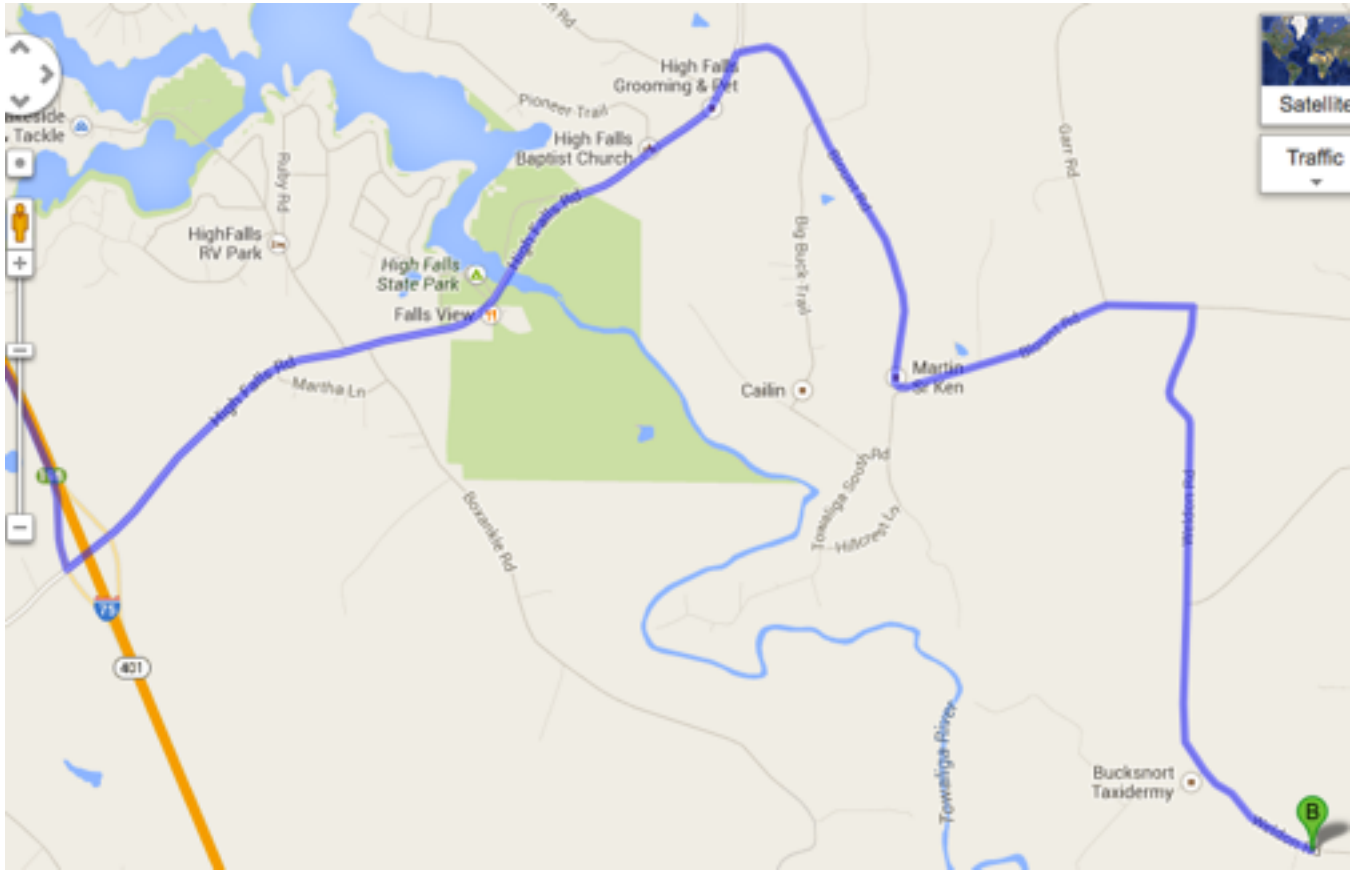
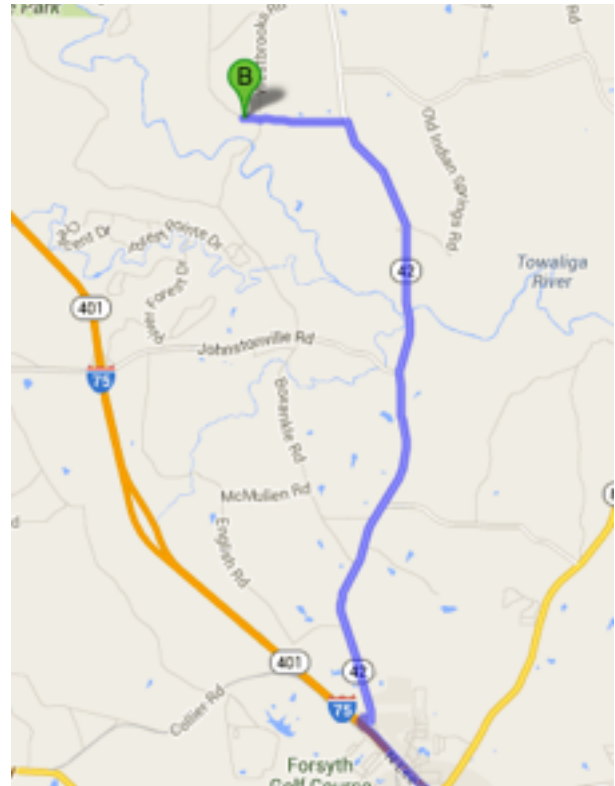
Turn right at Laurelbrook Dr



JANUARY MEETING DIRECTIONS TO CLAY

From Macon / Warner Robins take I -75 North to exit 188 (Highway 42 North) .This is a horseshoe ramp. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Highway 42N. Go 6.7 miles and Weldon Rd will be on your left (right past MM 23). If you go past a nursing home, you just missed it. Go 1.8 miles on Weldon Rd and my place is on the left. You will see the red metal building from the road. Be sure to take the driveway (2nd one) across from the mailbox marked 940.

From Atlanta, take I 75 South to exit 198 (High Falls Rd). turn left and go 2.7 miles (you will cross High Falls State Park Bridge) Turn right on Blount Rd. Take Blount Rd 2.2 miles to Weldon Rd on your right. Go 1.2 miles on Weldon, Mailbox for 940 will be on your left, my driveway is directly across it on the right. You will see the red metal building once you turn it the driveway.
