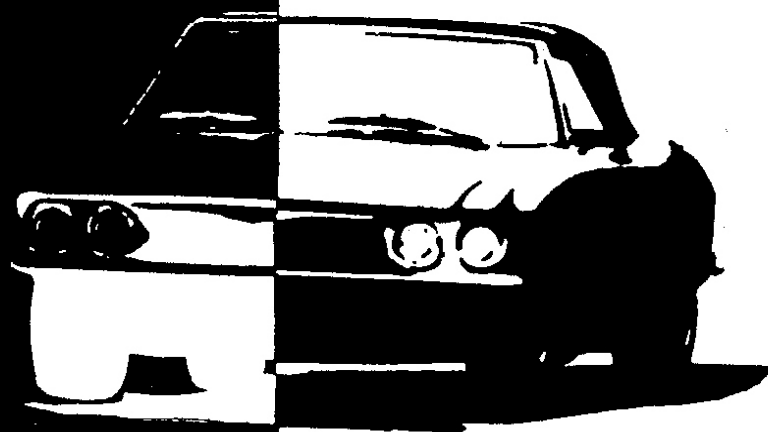

LIMOUSINE DRIVE TRAIN SWAP

On June 11th, the Corvair Club had its monthly meeting at Don Berding's to do the transaxle exchange in Don Filkins' limo.

We started the day with pizza and then had a brief meeting.

Several members got their hands dirty taking the drive train out of the limo and separating the engine from the transaxle. Others gave their opinions and watched the process.

The removal was easy using Don Berding's lift, dropping the engine down on a heavy steel table, and then rolling it out from under the car. Don Filkins had bought a junk car a couple years ago for the parts. That car hadn't been run in a number of years, but it was hoped that it would meet his needs.

At the end of the tech session, the exchange had been made. The only thing left to do was hook up all the wires, gas lines, linkages, etc.

During the next two weeks, Ralph Gubser, Don Filkins and Don Berding were able to accomplish that as well as replace the muffler, bushing on the stabilizer bars, a strut rod and replacing two 23-year-old tires.
