We will be meeting in Forsyth, GA on March 12 for the Forsythia Festival.

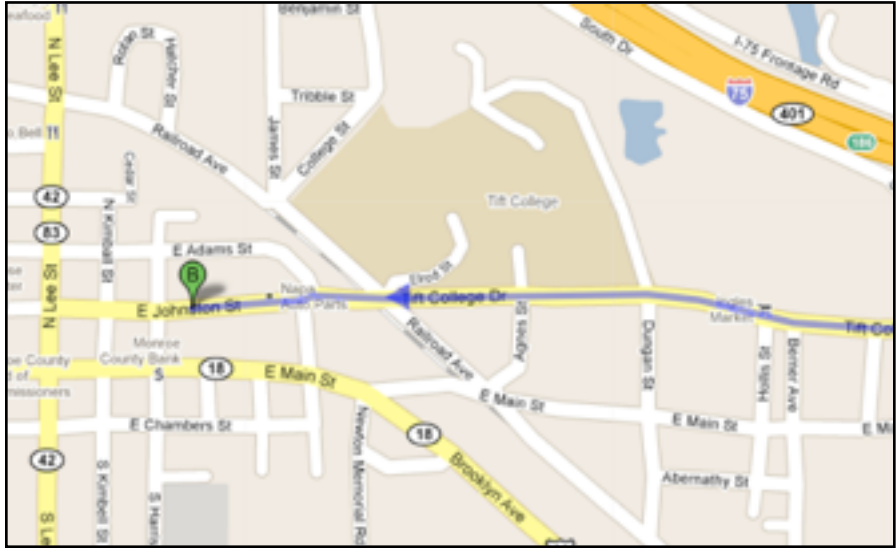
Take I-75 exit 186 (Juliette Road or Tift Drive) to Forsyth. Turn left if you were approaching from the south, right if approaching from the north.
